The capital letter is also called a big letter or upper- case letter, or sometimes just a capital.

When do you use a capital letter?

- Use a capital letter for the first letter in a sentence.

Ex. The phone is ringing.

Come here!

- Always use a capital letter for the word I : I am eight years old.
Tom and I are good friends.
- Use a capital letter for the names of people: Alice, Tom, James, Kim, Snow White .
- Use a capital letter for the names of places: National Museum, Bronx Zoo, London, Algeria .
- Use a capital letter for festivals, holidays, days of the week, months of the year: New Year's Day, Labor Day, Mother's Day, Sunday, Monday, Friday, January, May, July, October
