TASK 01: define the following: 10 / 20

- Acceptable risk levels: Level of risk judged to be outweighed by corresponding benefits or one that is of such degree that based on a set of criteria identified in a master plan.
- Action area: A specific area within a master plan identified by a set of criteria for detailed planning.
- Active open space: A recreation open space with the interface between the built form and the public realm.
- Activity node: An identifiable group of uses usually having a concentration of activities at a particular location.
- Base map: A map that indicates the significant existing physical features of an area. Rivers, streets, parks, etc.
- Biodiversity: Diversity among and within plants and animals in an environment.
- Biota: A collection of organisms including the animals, plants, fungi, etc.
- Block: An area of land surrounded by streets or combination of the local level and the development of an agency's resources, core skills and capabilities.
- Capacity development: The development of an agency's resources, core skills and capabilities.
- Carbon footprint: A measure of the amount of carbon dioxide emitted.
