

- > The 2017 Between the Lines session will include discussion of identity as it relates to creative writing, and the life of a writer. Please include a three to five (3-5) page personal statement/response to the following:
 - Family, friends, region, tribe, religious denomination, ethnic groups, class, gender, race, work, neighborhood, country, political parties—in our daily lives we navigate between different markers, adjusting our speech patterns and behavior to the demands of each encounter, narrating to ourselves stories about how and why we come to occupy a particular place in the scheme of things. What do you consider to be the strongest, most central aspects of your identity? What does it mean to you to be a member (or be seen as a member) of

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particular identity groups? In what way does your identity influence your creative writing?

- A statement of purpose (250 words maximum, in English) describing why creative writing is important in your life, and what you hope to learn at our program in Iowa.
